
Interesting Facts about Noya British School

Meet Our Counsellor



I am Lauren Pandit and I am the School Counsellor for Noya British School. I moved to Abu Dhabi from the UK in 2023. My passion for children's mental first developed health when completed my undergraduate degree in Psychology at Northumbria University in 2010. I then went on to complete my Masters in Social Work at Durham University in 2013 and have been a qualified Social Worker for the past 10+ years. I started off my career working in a children and families team where I completed direct work with children to ensure that their wishes were

at the center of our support plans. I worked with parents and took a holistic approach to see how we could best support the family. I then progressed to working in a mental health team, working alongside the Children and Adolescent mental health teams providing support to extremely vulnerable children and adults who were struggling with their mental health. In 2016 I completed further training at Northumbria University and qualified as an Approved Mental Health Professional (AMHP) where I could assess and support those with the most enduring and severe mental health difficulties.


I have worked with both children and adults offering support to improve mental health and overall wellbeing. I have substantial experience of supporting children who are neurodiverse, children with eating disorders and also with anxiety disorders. Throughout my career I have completed further psychological therapies training and have developed a vast toolbox of techniques and strategies to help support mental wellbeing.

My superpower is my ability to develop trusting relationships with the children that I work with, I ensure that the sessions are fun and we work together to fix the problem that the child is experiencing. I am very proactive and plan initiatives on how to prevent children from struggling with their mental health. I am extremely passionate about ensuring that children have a happy and positive schooling experience which will therefore improve their academic outcomes.

I am married and have 2 children who will also be attending Noya British School.
